


Character Hanger Santa Claus



Materials:

- 1. 1/2-1 Yard Craft Weight Stabilizer
- 2. Craft Brads Coordinating colors I used jingle bell brads
- 3. "Eye" from a hook and eye or an O-ring
- 4. Scrap fabrics for appliqués Red, White and Black
- 5. Sticky Stabilizer
- 6. All usual embroidery notions and threads.



- 1. Use your 5x7 or larger. Hoop a Sticky stabilizer, leaving paper on. Score the paper with a pin after hooping. Tear away paper leaving the sticky surface.
- 2. Cut Craft weight stabilizer to fit inside the hoop and stick it down.
- 3. Add as many of Santa's parts that fit chosen hoop. Sew out all designs. The appliqués will sew out in this order. Click here or copy and paste in address bar for appliqué directions https://sewswell.com/applique-tutorial/
- 4. With appliqués complete, carefully cut out designs close to the satin stitch but not into. (Fray Check) if needed.
- 5. Use an awl to punch a hole in the eyelets
- 6. Line your eyelet parts together. Head to chest, arms to shoulder...etc. Push brads through the holes and open them up to combine body parts.
- 7. Stitch "eye" or O-ring at top back of Santa's Hat
- 8. Use Ribbon or cord, yarn to hang your positional Santa Claus!
