


Choose Design Part A
Hoop water
soluble stabilizer
stitch first color.



Turn hoop over lay wrong side of the bottom fabric on the stabilzer and tape in place.



Turn hoop back
layer batting and
fabric on top.
Stitch next color to
Tie down fabric layers.




Remove hoop from machine
cut away excess fabric
and batting as close
to the stitches as possible without
cutting trough stitches or stabilizer.
Do the same for the back.
Replace hoop



Stitch remaining colors
Stop before last color
change to match bobbin
with the top thread
for the satin stitch edge.



Finish sewing Part A
Remove from hoop
Carefully remove excess stabilizer.
Pulls easily from the satin stitches
may need to cut around
the face.



Choose Design Part B
Hoop water
soluble stabilizer
sandwich stabilizer with
bottom, top fabric and
batting contine the same
as the Part A



When quilting is finished
Stop at placement
line stitching
front of face.
Place part A lining
up facial features and edges
tape in place

Hint: you can wet the WSS slightly then stick part A to the WSS in the hoop!



There will be a tack down stitch.

Make any adjustments as needed.

Stop here change bobbin match top thread for satin stitch finish.

Remove excess stabilizer It is Finished
